JORDAN: WALKS, TREKS, CAVES, CLIMBS AND CANYONS

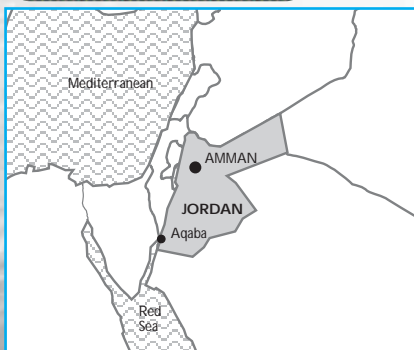
INFORMATION

A new edition guidebook to the superlative routes found in Jordan's recently formed Nature Reserves. There are walks, treks, caves and climbs described in this wonderful landscape, based around Pella, Ajlun, Moab, Dana, Petra and Wadi Rum.

This book not only gives descriptions to 150 routes, most previously unknown prior to the 1st edition, but also provides information on new climbing areas and other areas still unexplored for those who wish to make their own discoveries. It gives information on how to get there, when to go, what to take and everything you need to know about the routes. In doing so, it offers you an opportunity to see and experience a country of great antiquity and previously unsuspected remarkable beauty, making a plea to respect the land and its people, both largely unspoilt by tourism.

It is rare for a book of this nature to describe such a wealth of previously unknown and varied terrain, but their discoveries reveal an unexpected land of forested hills, beautiful dales carpeted in flowers, huge canyons sometimes with fast flowing rivers, recently discovered caves, perfect limestone cliffs in wooded valleys and high mountains with lunar landscapes.

AREA MAP

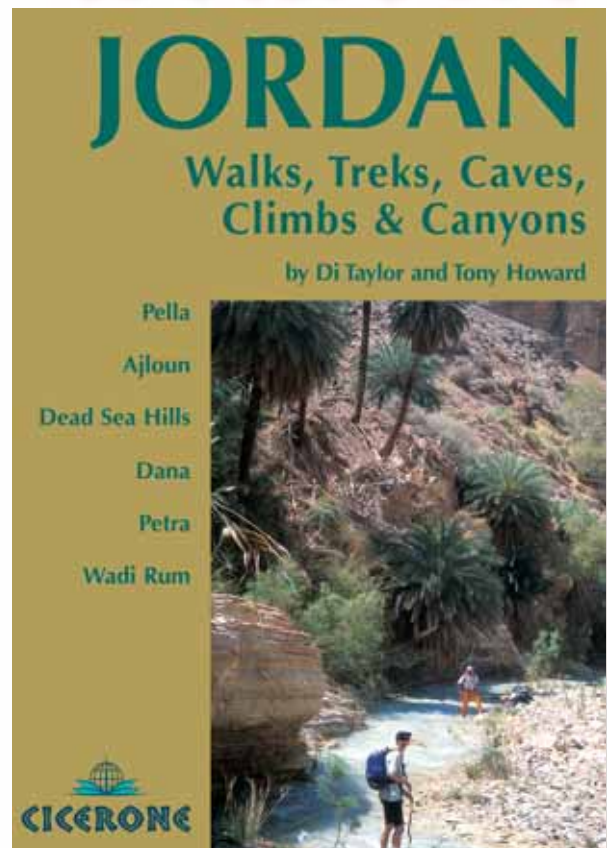


THE AUTHOR
