Lakeland Fellranger THE NEAR EASTERN FELLS

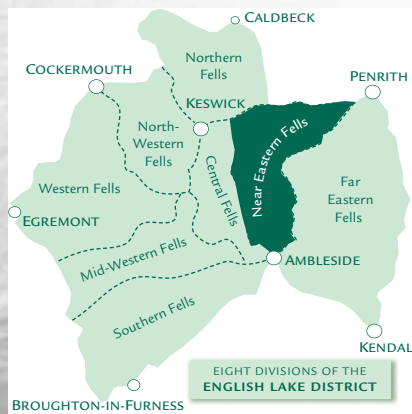
INFORMATION

Cicerone's Lakeland Fellranger series is the modern rucksack reference for the discerning fell adventurer. Fellrangers are inspirational and thorough – and together the eight books in the series provide a comprehensive and contemporary guide to the fells of the English Lake District.

The guides in the Fellranger series are ideal for practical use outdoors, and are equally useful for armchair planning. Each fell has its own dedicated chapter, and the variety of routes on the fell are carefully depicted on Harvey maps and fellscape diagrams. The scenic qualities of the landscape are illustrated by colour photographs and by detailed summit panoramas that help to underpin the reader's appreciation of these magical mountains.

The Near Eastern Fells comprise the mighty range of hills, including Helvellyn, lying between Ambleside and Threlkeld. The area is flanked to the west by Grasmere, Dunmail Raise and Thirlmere, and to the east by Kirkstone Pass, Patterdale and Ullswater.

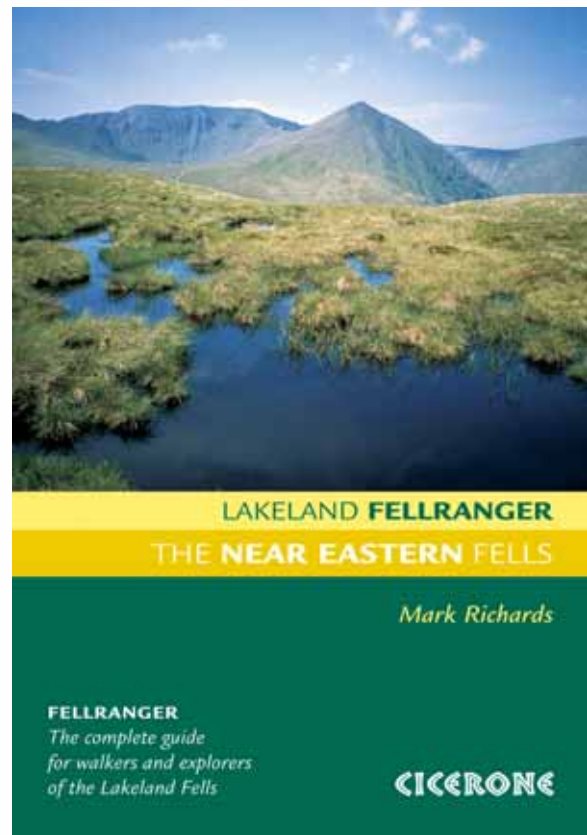
