The delights of Italy's magical Monti Sibillini are revealed for the first time for English speakers in this new walking guide, covering 21 walks and the eight-day Grande Anello dei Sibillini trek that encircles the rugged mountainous massif and Sibillini National Park.

Vast highlands smothered in blazes of wildflowers, wondrous canyons burrowing deep into mountainsides, hospitable villages, approachable ridges with breathtaking views, days on end of vast horizons – the Monti Sibillini have something for everyone.

Handy for the airports on Italy's Adriatic coast and for Rome, the Sibillini belong to the Apennine chain straddling the Marche and Umbria, and are bound to become popular as overseas visitors discover their delights.

Visitors are advised to come equipped with a sense of adventure (along with a compass, map and this guidebook). But beware as wolves are at large and even bears hibernate here!

THE AUTHOR

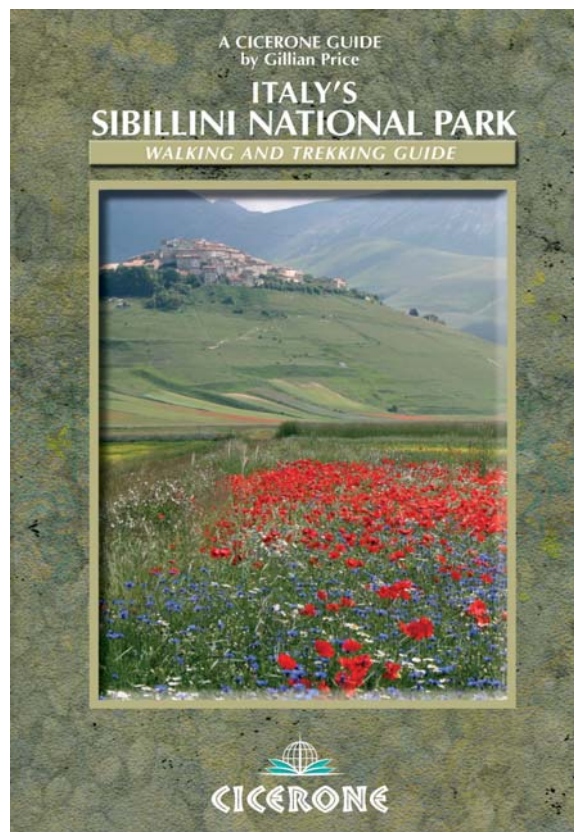
