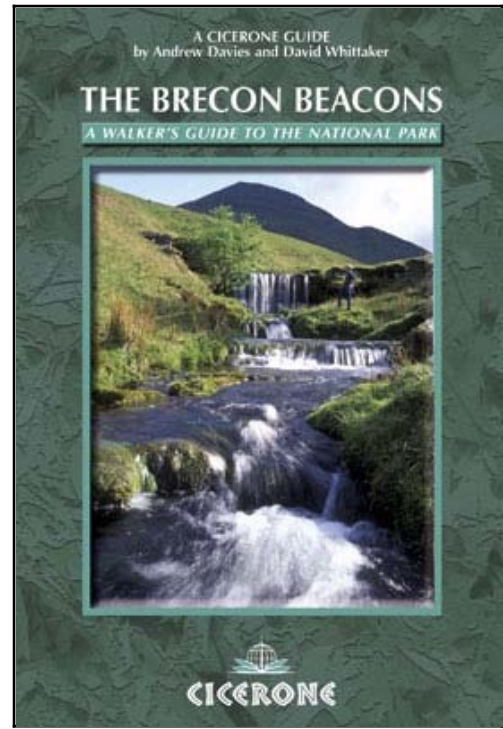


## THE AUTHORS
