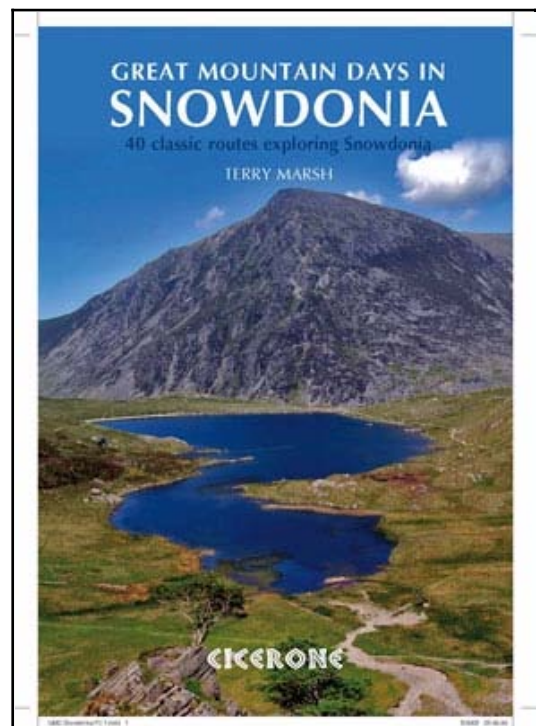


### THE AUTHOR
