

WALKING IN DERBYSHIRE

INFORMATION

Numerous walking books have been written about the Peak District, home of Britain's first and most visited national park, which covers roughly half of Derbyshire. This guide has a broader scope. It offers comprehensive coverage of whole of the county of Derbyshire, including the Peak District but also the less-visited and contrasting, gentler landscapes south of Ashbourne and Derby.

The 60 day walks described in detail here are set against the backdrop of the varied and beautiful Derbyshire landscape and cover an extensive range of historical themes. Routes pass remnants of ancient civilisations, fine market towns and villages, caverns and mines, castles, grand country houses and parklands, Georgian and Victorian spa resorts and industrial heritage sites and the book is full of all the background information walkers need to appreciate the local history.

Walks range between 2 and 10 miles long, over a wide variety of terrain, offering something for walkers of all abilities and all this lies in the heart of England, with excellent accessibility from all parts of Britain.

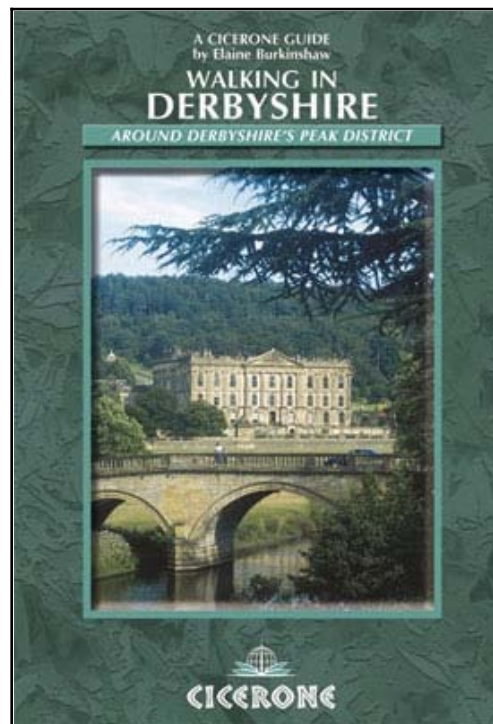


THE AUTHOR
