## THE AUTHOR

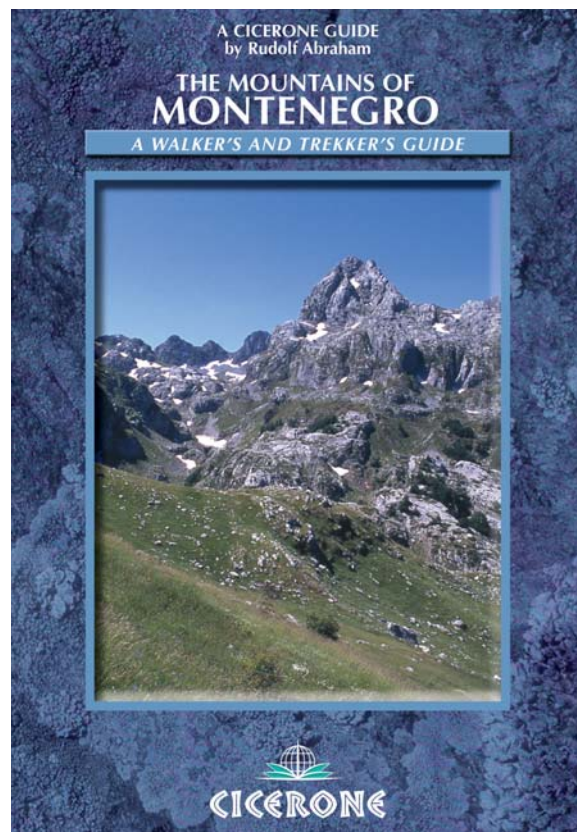
