The GR7 in Andalucía passes through the most geographically varied region on the Iberian peninsular, with pine forests, semi-arid desert badlands, snow-capped peaks, fertile plains, traditional villages, lush valleys, olive groves and hills of cork woodland.

The route starts on the coast at Tarifa, the southernmost tip of Spain, and meanders for 268km through Cádiz and Málaga before dividing. The northern fork heads through Córdoba and Jaén provinces, while the southern fork passes through Almería and Granada. It passes through seven natural parks and the Sierra Nevada national park.

This guide covers the whole of the GR7 in Andalucía. It gives detailed route descriptions for around 70 full days of walking, but also offers options for creating shorter sections and days. It also includes accommodation information.

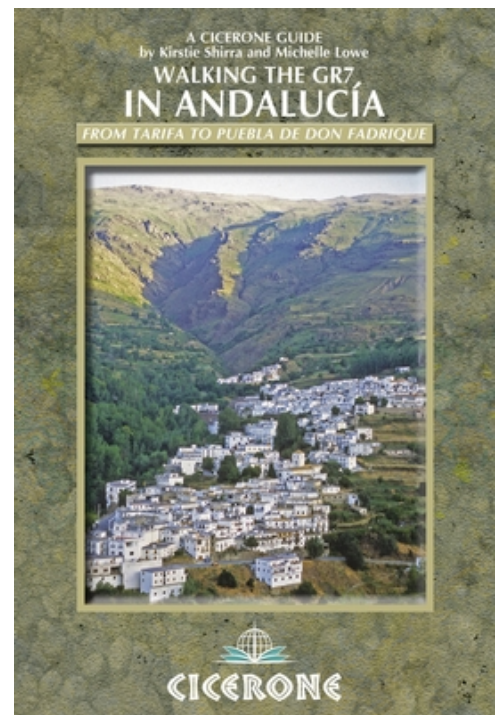
